

I recommend first looking at the "Help" section of each for guidance on how to use the "Advanced Search" interface of each one. Searches can be saved for future reference. Generally, enclose the words "Aquatic Park" in quotation marks in order to search that specific phrase. Searching San Francisco sources will always have a large excess of results that are about SF's Aquatic Park.

Berkeley Public Library < berkeleypubliclibrary.org >:

• A simple keyword search "Berkeley Aquatic Park" entered in the main search box will give a result showing various government documents & reports on the subject, all kept for in-Library use at the Central Library, 2090 Kittredge Street. The Berkeley History Room, also located at the Central Library, has clippings files on Aquatic Park.
